**Subject: Introduction of the Digital Embarkation and Disembarkation Form**

Dear Mr. Reddy,

In line with our commitment to streamlining travel processes and enhancing convenience, we are pleased to announce the launch of the Digital Embarkation and Disembarkation Form. This new digital system, which replaces the traditional paper-based process, enables travelers to complete necessary entry and exit formalities online. The soft launch of the Digital Embarkation and Disembarkation Form (Immigration Custom Form) will commence on 01 November 2024.

To facilitate a smooth transition, a two-and a half month grace period will be in effect, during which both digital and physical forms will be accepted. Travelers may continue to use the physical form until 14 January 2025. From 15 January 2025, the Digital Embarkation and Disembarkation Form will be mandatory for all entries and exits.

All travelers intending to enter Suriname are kindly requested to complete this digital form in advance of their travel via the following link: [www.icf.sr](http://www.icf.sr).

The Ministry respectfully requests that this new requirement be communicated to the relevant stakeholders, with a request for its broad dissemination among all concerned parties. This will help ensure that all travelers and stakeholders are informed and in compliance with the updated entry and exit formalities.
